- 1. Commander Arlen Stiefvater opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2. Secretary Henry Reist read the minutes for the 12-15-10 meeting and they were approved.
- 3.Treasurer John Deveraux gave his report. He indicated that we had Flag renewals adding up to \$6,825 in 2010. As of 12-31-10 our balance in the checking and saving account was \$6895.11. In January up to 1-19-2011 we received \$1265. In flag renewals and the checking balance was 3,016.51 with the Money Market at \$5,116.90 for a total of \$8133.41.
- 4. We had a successful workday on Saturday and made 220 flags in a little over 2 hours
- 5. The Commander indicated that we will have another flag work day on January 29.
- 6. The Commander stated our accomplishments for 2010: 1)widening the sidewalk outside the clubhouse 2) Establishing the Memory Walk with 21 trees planted, watering system installed, headstone, flags, and benches installed. The expected total for the project is \$9000 with the tree project to be completed in 2011. In addition, we have contributed \$300. To the Sewing Club for throws for veterans at the VA Hospital and a \$500. Contribution to the <u>USO</u> for phone cards for active duty personnel.
- 7. There was a discussion about the proper charge for new residents to have flags.
- 8. Our 2010 officers were given thanks for their efforts.
- 9. A suggestion was made to get a cover for the sidewalk that we had widened. Bob Stockinger will investigate the possibility.
- 10. For Presidents Day on February 21, the plan is to put up the flags on Saturday 2-19 and take them down on Tuesday 2-22.
- 11. We haven't heard yet from Benny Rains on purchase of trees.
- 12. Dutch Uran talked about putting a bronze rose on the memory walk headstone. There was a discussion about the best foundry and possible cost.
- 13. Judith Winchell made a motion which was seconded and passed to authorize Dutch up to \$ 600. To start the process and cast the bronze rose original.
- 14. Vice Commander David Winchell talked about future New Years party plans. All clubs are being asked to accept responsibility. There is a stated need for seed money.

- 15. Mike Sanders made a motion that was seconded and passed that we put in \$300 seed money for the New Years party.
- 16. The clubhouse flag responsibility for a month will be Mike Donoho and Tom Paterno.
