

COMCAST DIGITAL MIGRATION NOTICE

If you do not have a digital box on a television set with standard cable service or higher, you may be at risk of losing channels 21-52 & 56-80. Please call 1-800-comcast or 1-877-634-4434 to secure two digital adapters today at no cost. You'll also receive more communication from us in the mail in regards to the network enhancement and timing for your area.

When you call Comcast they will want your account number or telephone number and street address. Comcast will mail the adapters by UPS and they should arrive within 5-7 days. The instructions are to install the adapter between the TV and cable connections, then to call Comcast to have them activated. No additional adapter is required for a TV that is already hooked up with the Digital, HD, or DVR box. The adapters are only required if you simply connect to cable with no box or adapter. If you need more than two adapters they will charge \$1.99/month for each additional adapter.

Feb 22 is the day this digital migration will be effective for BellaVita. There are a lot of channels in the range that the notice says will be gone without the adapters. When the adapters arrive at your house, and if you are unable to set them up, call Comcast and have a service technician come to your home to set them up. Ask if there is a charge for the service call.

BellaVita Fence Options Information

The Board of Directors has been considering the impact of continuing to handle all fence maintenance in BellaVita and is seeking input from homeowners. Poor initial quality and rapid deterioration of some fences led the Board to appoint a task force last year to look at long term fence costs.

The Task Force found that much better quality fences were available at lower than expected costs, and recommended that we begin to replace all fences over a 12 year period starting in 2013. The cost for doing so would amount to a reserve budget increase of \$2 per month per home and this amount was included in the current budget. While it did not require an immediate increase in assessments, it may serve to move up the time when increases are necessary. However, long-term costs would be greatly reduced.

Another option considered is for the association to turn the responsibility for unit fences back over to homeowners. This would reduce costs and extend the time before assessments have to be raised. These two options represent the maximum and minimum short-range costs of those options being considered, and the Board would very much like homeowner input to the decision. A survey will be mailed to each home on February 17 along with some additional information. Your opinions are important and the Board requests that each family review the issues and return the surveys to the ballot box in the clubhouse.

To learn more about the issue please attend the Homeowners Forum at 7pm on February 23 where the Board will address your questions.
