





BellaVita Awards committee as well as the BV Sewing Group would like to recognize the notable sewing duo, Rita Hedges and Nancy Bouman. Rita and her husband, Dave, moved to BellaVita March 2013. Before retirement she was a radiology technologist. Nancy and her husband, Bernie, moved to Bellavita in 2016 from Plain City, Ohio to be closer to their daughter in Pearland. Nancy was a computer programmer at Kent State University.

Rita and Nancy have the love and passion for their craft which makes them the experts that they are. Both are very active in the sewing group. One of their special projects is the Veterans Patriotic Quilts, which is extremely rewarding



for them as well as the entire sewing group. They keep the group on track with new ideas that advance their sewing skills. Nancy is responsible for purchasing all the needed supplies. After joining the sewing group in 2019, Rita taught the group to quilt. She is a long arm quilter and quilted the majority of the Veterans quilts. Each quilt takes Rita between 3-4 hours to quilt. - Patriotic guilts for BV residents that have served in the Military
- Stuffed Animals for children in hospitals and at Christmas; stockings for newborns for photos and baby booties
- Dresses for children in the Philippines and Mexico, working with Crossroads Church
- Walker bags for Veterans
- Special projects for Texas Children's Hospital: Denim Water bottles, Heart shaped pillows for heart patients, ribbons for Child Abuse Week
- Cat hammocks for cats being transported by rescue organizations

Nancy stresses that you don't need to sew to be a member of this group, there are many projects that don't require sewing, and everyone is welcome. The sewing group has grown and they believe that it is because of volunteers like Rita and Nancy.

With all their time and effort spent with the sewing group, they are also involved in other BV groups.

Here are 25 fascinating facts about pi:

- **1.** The <u>symbol for Pi</u> has been in use for over 250 years. The symbol was introduced by William Jones, a Welsh mathematician, in 1706.
- **2.** Since the exact value of pi can never be calculated, we can never find the accurate area or circumference of a circle.
- 3. March 14 or 3/14 is celebrated as pi day because 3.14 are the first digits of pi.
- **4.** The record for reciting the most number of decimal places of Pi was achieved by Rajveer Meena at VIT University, Vellore, India on 21 March 2015. He was able to recite 70,000 decimal places while blindfolded.
- **5.** Pi is actually a part of Egyptian mythology. People in Egypt believed that the pyramids of Giza were built on the principles of pi.
- **6.** Physicist Larry Shaw started celebrating 14 March as Pi day at San Francisco's Exploratorium science museum. There he is known as the Prince of Pi.
- **7.** Pi wasn't always known as pi . The Welsh mathematician William Jones, a friend of Sir Isaac Newton, began using the symbol for pi in 1706.
- **8.** We will never be able to find all the digits of pi because of its very definition as an irrational number. This record was broken in 2017 when a Swiss scientist computed more than 22 trillion digits of pi. The calculation took over a hundred days.
- **9.** In 2009, Congress passed Resolution 224, which designated March 14th as pi day. Congress hoped that celebrating pi day would cultivate a higher level of enthusiasm for math and science among American students.
- **10.** Givenchy sells a men's cologne with the name 'Pi'. The company markets this product as capable of enhancing the attractiveness of intelligent and visionary men.
- **11.** The number pi is literally infinitely long. But the number 123456 doesn't appear anywhere in the first million digits of pi
- **12.** In ancient times, mathematicians used a unique method to calculate pi. They would add more and more sides to a polygon so that its area approached the area of a circle.
- **13.** The number pi is very effective when you used in calculations For instance, rounding the number pi to just 9 digits after the decimal and use it to calculate earth's circumference yield incredibly accurate results. For every 25,000 miles, the number pi will only err to 1/4th of an inch.
- **14.** Even today, people are racing to calculate more digits of pi in a never ending competition. In the year 2010, a Japanese engineer and an American computer wizard broke the record for the most number of pi digits by calculating up to 5 trillion digits of pi. The amazing part is that they didn't use any supercomputers. They just used desktop computers, 20 external hard disks, and their brilliant minds.
- **15.** Interestingly, one of the most famous scientists in the world have a connection to pi day. Albert Einstein was born on March 14th,1879.
