Snake Season





Yes its Snake season again! It will pass in a matter of 2-4 weeks. Why is this happening? The snakes are waking up from winter hibernation, entering into mating season, looking for food and are looking for warm spots to sun (since they do not have the ability to control their internal temperature). Most of the snakes will be non-venomous banded water snakes, but we do have a couple venomous snakes in Bella Vita, the small slender coral snakes and water moccasins. The water snake may look alot like a water moccasin because they both may be really dark in coloration. The way to distinguish (from a distance) is the water snake will have a long and slender tail and verticle stripes on its lower mouth. A water moccasin will be dark in coloration and have a short stubby tail. Alot of folks talk about a spade shaped head, but both snakes can appear to have triangular head - the tail is the true distinguishing factor.

If snakes are in your yard, they are seeking food. They don't just wander around. They use heat sensors in the nasal area to identify food sources and proceed towards them, such as mice, rats, baby bunnies, baby opossums, frogs and even birds from time to time.

The best way to keep snakes out of your yard is to remove all food sources or things that attract food sources, such as bird seed and dog poop. The best way to get a snake to leave your yard is to spray it with your water hose. Remember if you are trying to kill the snake you may be putting yourself in danger by getting within striking range. Whatever you do, keep your eyes open and be careful.

White Bat

Ingredients

- 11/2 ounces white rum
- 1/2 ounce Kahlúa
- ◆ 11/2 ounces whole milk
- 3 ounces cola, chilled
- Garnish: mint leaves

Steps

- Add all the ingredients to a highball glass filled with ice and stir briefly and gently to combine.
- 2. Garnish with mint leaves.

As the HOA Communication Committee Chair, Lark took the lead on this project, which started in March 2020 and scheduled for Fall 2020. As we all know Covid hit and the project was canceled. Then, the company selected to take the pictures went out of business.

So another search for a company resumed in June 2021. After a lengthy search, a company from Tennessee was found to meet the needs of the BV Community. In addition to publishing the Pictorial Directory each resident who had their photo taken received a free 8x10 and directory at no cost to residents or Bellavita. The company selected usually doesn't do non-church groups as well as travel this far. With Lark's salesmanship and persistence skills he closed the deal. Once the company was selected, the project resumed in July 2021 with a 6 month timeline. By late December 2021, the Telemarketing Team made calls to BV residents. To get more onboard, Lark used great communication skills to build awareness. He promoted the Pictorial Project via BV newsletter, BV Grapevine, door fliers, and phone calls. He enlisted coordinators and Block Captains as well as serving as liaison to the Portrait Company.

The project advanced to January 2022, when photo sessions were scheduled over 3 weeks. Lark's committee members, other volunteers, BV Staff and the Portrait Company did an outstanding job under Lark's leadership. This committee made it easy and smooth for all residents.

As you can see Lark spent many long hours/days/weeks/months in organizing, coordinating, land implementing this major task, the BV Pictorial Directory project. Because of Lark's leadership, diligence, persistence, and vision, a total of 425 (70%) households will be represented in the Directory as compared to 2015 at 47% of households.

With the support and understanding of his wife, Bonnie and family, Lark has given so much time and effort to enhance the BellaVita spirit.



Everyone should be watering at least two days a week

Your HOA dues include having your front door maintained every 2 yrs. This means the door will be lightly sanded and a coat of spar varnish will be applied. A new weather strip on the bottom of the door is included, if needed. This will help to protect your door. However, if you postpone or do not request having your door serviced and it requires having your door refinished, the HOA will only cover a portion of the cost to refinish and replace the weather strip. The HOA will pay a maximum of \$210.00 (the cost to the HOA for regular maintenance plus a 2nd coat of varnish). You will be responsible for the remaining cost of the door service. Please note if there is a homeowner cost it will have gone up from previous years as well. It is your responsibility to call and have it serviced every 2 years. Please call Jerry Marshburn at 281-998-7709 or come by or contact the Clubhouse at 281-464-3150 before October and get on the schedule. The doors are serviced March through October.
