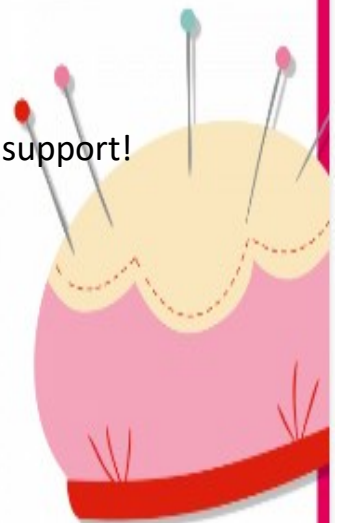
*It could be a little girl's dress!*

1. **DON'T** use the CenterPoint web site to report light outages or broken lights. It will take the information but it doesn't go anywhere where someone will access the information and use it.
2. **CALL IN** broken lights to 713-207-2222.
3. **WHEN YOU CALL IN**, get the tracking number. CenterPoint cannot pull up information in their data base by light number. But with a tracking number, it will pull up the light pole and all its history in addition to the current tracking number.
4. **DO FOLLOW UP**, on the light repair by seeing the broken light site first. Then call 713-207-2222. Why? CenterPoint will mark a tracking number as completed when it is not. It takes about 4 business days for them to visit the light once a tracking number is issued. Then, 2-3 weeks to pull the parts together and repair, after the initial inspection.

# PERFECTLY PUZZLING

LOTS of our BellaVita neighbors are **Jigsaw fans**. There are MANY lovely **puzzles** in your BellaVita Library, and they **come and go most frequently!**

There are **puzzles everywhere** from **300 pieces** (some with LARGE, easy-to-handle pieces) all the way to **1000+ pieces**. And there are even some “**Special Shape**” **puzzles** and a “**Mystery Puzzle**” where you don’t even know what the picture IS until you finish it! What a fun challenge! There are **CHILDREN’S puzzles** in the CHILDREN section as well.

## So. How does this work?

Just as with BOOK borrowing, you just **take a PUZZLE, work it, and return it.**

There are no “rules”, but there are some “**Polite Puzzler Practices**” that you are encouraged to use. **Such as:**

- **Return puzzles** with all the **pieces inside a zip-lock plastic bag** in the puzzle box. This goes a long way to prevent *lost pieces*.
- If you find an **extra piece in the box**, return it to the “**Lost and Found**” **puzzle piece bowl** on the sign-in table.
- If your puzzle is **MISSING a piece**, put a sticky note **on the outside of the box** that there is a piece missing when you return it. ***That puzzle will NOT go back on the shelves!***

# COVID-19 Vaccine Card: Do's & Don'ts

## **Do keep your card somewhere safe**

"Your vaccine card is important because it documents which COVID-19 vaccine you received and when you received it. We're still learning about the durability of these vaccines, but this information will be important if it's determined that booster shots are needed after some time," says Dr. Long. "It will help guide the timing of your booster, as well as which vaccine you should receive during your booster."

Lastly, Dr. Long points out that, as we reach towards our new normal, documentation that you're fully vaccinated may eventually be required for:

- Traveling
- Attending school and/or a university
- Participating in certain activities
- Attending large events

"Plus, some businesses are offering discounts and deals for those who are vaccinated, and you'll likely need to show your card in some form or fashion to benefit," adds Dr. Long.

## **Don't laminate your card**

So, now that you know how important your vaccine card is, you might be thinking you need to keep it super safe. And you do.

But, here's why you should avoid laminating it.

"Since your vaccination card may need to be updated with booster shot information in the future, laminating your card may eventually cause more headache than help," says Dr. Long. "If you really want to carry your original around, you're better off placing it in a water-tight, sheet protector. They're actually making these sized for vaccination cards these days."

If you've already laminated your vaccine card, don't panic. If your card does need to be updated in the future, having it already laminated just means that you will receive a second vaccine card at that time — and you will need to keep track of both cards

## **Do take a photo of the front and back**

"There's really no need to carry the original copy of your vaccination card around with you as of right now. Instead, take a picture of both the front and back of your card, save digital copies to your phone and personal cloud storage, and then store your original card away for safe keeping," recommends Dr. Long.

In the event that you lose your vaccination card, having a digital copy can help tide you over until you can get a replacement, and it may even expedite the process of getting a replacement card.

If you lose your card, bring your photo ID to your vaccine provider and they'll be able to look you up and provide a duplicate card. And, having a digital copy may be helpful as they check their records, since you'll know the exact date you received your dose(s).

## **Don't post a photo of your vaccine card on social media**

Speaking of taking photos of your vaccination card...

"Getting your COVID-19 vaccine feels empowering, but avoid the urge to share your excitement by posting your vaccination card on social media," warns Dr. Long. "Your personal information is on that card, including your name and birth date, and linking that information to your social media profile is concerning from an identity-theft standpoint."

Instead, Dr. Long recommends snapping a selfie of your arm and Band-Aid after your shot.

"Some providers are even handing out vaccination stickers right now, which I think is a great way to share your excitement with others. Taking a selfie with your sticker is a safer way to let your friends, family and followers know you got vaccinated," adds Dr. Long.



## Monday 5/3 Green Waste Update

Waste Management is completing Wednesday's green waste route and will then begin on the Thursday green waste route.

Waste Management (WM) continues to run green waste trucks on a delayed schedule due to an increase in yard waste, both seasonal and remnants of dead brush/trees from the February freeze. This is a temporary delay in service as WM will run green waste trucks through a route until completely serviced, which may take 3-5 days per route. This has resulted in a 2-3 week lapse between green waste service days. WM regular trash trucks may recover small loads of green waste where possible and if it does not impede the timely recovery of household trash. Due to this schedule, it is possible residents may accumulate more than 10 bags/bundles that WM will recover when passing through routes. WM will green tag green waste in excess of 10 bags or green waste not properly bundled. Should this occur or if needing green waste removed before WM is able to service route it is recommended residents consider other options to remove green waste:

- Request landscapers to remove excessive green waste and not leave on curb
- Purchase a Bagster for excessive green waste and schedule pick-up by Waste Management at 800.800.5804 (fees associated with removal; Bagster can hold up to 3-cubic yards / 3000 pounds of debris)
- Take green waste to landfill

A new weather strip on the bottom of the door is included, if needed. This will help to protect your door. However, if you postpone or do not request having your door serviced and it requires having your door refinished, the HOA will only cover a portion of the cost to refinish and replace the weather strip. The HOA will pay a maximum of \$180 (the cost to the HOA for regular maintenance plus a 2nd coat of varnish). You will be responsible for the remaining cost of the door service. It is your responsibility to call and have it serviced every 2 years. Please call Jerry Marshburn at 281-998-7709 or come by or contact the Clubhouse at 281-464-3150 before October and get on the schedule. The doors are serviced March through October.

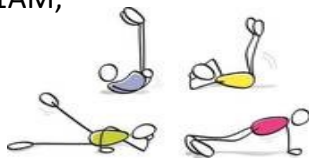

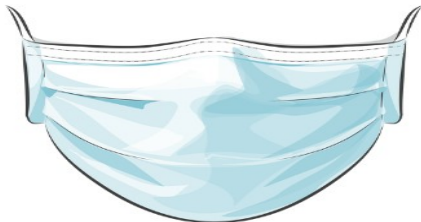
