BELLAVITA VETERANS

The Grounds Committee would like to express their sincere appreciation to the BellaVita Veterans organization. For several years the grounds committee has struggled with funding for common ar-

ea grounds improvements. Already aging vegetation was impacted negatively by unprecedented rainfall and freezing events and extra expenses have been incurred associated with landscape contract turnovers. All in all, the committee has had very little extra funds for common area improvements. The Veterans organization generously chose to provide the necessary funds to make a major improvement to one of BellaVita's very visible common areas. The area is referred to as "the horse shoe area" and is located between the pool water overflow area and the lake walk way. Their funds will pay for all labor and materials associated with demolishing and removal of existing dead, dying and invasive vegetation, tree trimming, installation of fresh soil mix, mulch, crushed granite, large accent boulders, landscape edging, installation of lower maintenance vegetation as well as providing 2 benches.



Rusticscapes recommends that all homeowners monitor their watering



MOSQUITO PREVENTION CHECKLIST

What You Need to Know

Hot weather and standing water come with significant nuisances related to pest control. One of the most dangerous and annoying pests that need control in Houston are mosquitoes. Bringing deadly diseases at worst and itchy bites at best, mosquitoes can be prevented and managed through basic diligence and access to professional pest control services. Three forms of mosquito control include preventing breeding sources, protecting yourself, and caring for your community.


<u>Prevent Breeding Sources</u> Mosquitoes breed prolifically, laying eggs and developing colonies at a rapid rate. Because mosquito larvae need still water to survive, any area on your property with standing water acts as a perfect home for mosquitoes to grow their families. One of the main objectives for mosquito control and prevention is getting rid of standing water.

<u>Protect Yourself-</u>Even with a significant amount of breeding prevention, it's impossible to keep your property completely mosquito free. Install screens or repair holes in existing screens, keep landscape plants, trees, and shrubs trimmed, avoid times when mosquitoes are most active, such as dawn or dusk, and wear DEET spray repellent, along with long sleeves, long pants, and light colors in the evening.

<u>Care For Your Community</u> Your neighborhood or community may be at risk of breeding or hosting mosquito colonies. Watch out for these situations in your area. Report disruptions in nature that may cause mosquito problems such as green or abandoned swimming pools, hot tubs, or other bodies of standing water, pick up litter that may collect water, and keep your neighborhood clean.


