

The City of Pearland has partnered with Frontier Waste Solutions for Solid Waste and Recycling Services as of Friday, October 1, 2021. This publication provides Residential Services Guidelines for: Trash, Recycling, and Bulky Waste / Green (Yard) Waste

*** PLEASE DO NOT SET OUT FRONTIER LOGO TRASH CART FOR SERVICE UNTIL AFTER OCTOBER 1st***

OLD RECYCLING CARTS WILL BE COLLECTED IN SEPTEMBER, USE FRONTIER RECYCLING CART WHEN OLD CART IS REMOVED. WASTE MANAGEMENT WILL SERVICE FRONTIER RECYCLE CART UNTIL OCTOBER 1st

RECYCLING SERVICES: Recycle Carts (Green with Yellow Lid) will be collected one (1) time per week on the same day as your current collection schedule. See map on back page for schedule. Please have your cart our at the curb prior to 7 am on your service day and place it 4 feet from any other object (mailbox, car, other cart) with the lid opening facing the street.

ITEMS THAT CAN BE RECYCLED:

- * Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Office Paper
- * Cardboard, Boxboard (EX: beverage can boxes)
- * Aluminum Cans, Metal / Tin Cans (EX: Green Bean Cans)
- * Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Containers numbered #1, 2, 3, 5 and 7
- Glass Bottles & Jars (clear, green, amber)

PLEASE DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS AND PUT THEM IN YOUR RECYCLING CART.

ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE RECYCLED:

- * NO Plastic bags (EX: Trash Bags, Grocery Bags)
- NO Plastic Packaging or Foam Packaging
- * NO Ceramics
- NO Metal or Glass Cookware
- NO Paper Towels, Soiled Paper Plates, or Plastic Cookware
- NO Plate Glass or Window Glass
- NO Food or Wet Waste
- NO Leaves, Grass Clippings, Branches, Dirt, Rocks, Mulch
- NO Light Bulbs
- NO Packaging (foam packing peanuts, plastic air packs, etc...)
- NO Styrofoam

TRASH SERVICES: Trash Carts (Gray with Green Lid) will be collected two (2) times per week. ALL TRASH MUST BE INSIDE THE TRASH CART. See map on back page for collection schedule. Please have your cart our at the curb prior to 7 am on your service day and place it 4 feet from any other object (mailbox, car, other cart) with the lid opening facing the street. Please bag your trash to reduce wind-blown material.

Bulk & Greenwaste/Yardwaste Services: Frontier Waste will collect TWO (2) Cubic Yards of Bulk Waste/ Greenwaste material, collected together, one (1) time per week. See map on back page for collection schedule— Bulk / Greenwaste will be collected on your Recycle service day. Two (2) Cubic Yards is roughly 6 ft x 3 ft x 3 ft of material. Bush/Branches need to be tied and bundled in maximum 4 ft bundles not exceeding 40 pounds in weight.

<u>Bulky Items include</u>: small furniture, mattresses, appliances (freon must be removed from refrigerator's by a licensed technician before removal - Call a local refrigerant company for this service)

- ** Please bag leaves in clear bags or paper bags so that Greenwaste material can be identified.
- ** As a second option, Leaves and grass clippings can be put in TRASH cart on trash service day.
- ** If you have materials exceeding the weekly Two (2) Cubic Yard limit, please call 936-258-9035 or email Frontier Waste at pearland@frontierwaste.com to have a supervisor conduct a service call and provide an estimate and schedule material removal.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW): Household Hazardous waste will be accepted at the Keep Pearland Beautiful Stella Roberts Recycling Center located at 5800 Magnolia Pkwy, Pearland, Texas.

INGREDIENTS


- 2 ounces* Fireball whiskey

A new weather strip on the bottom of the door is included, if needed. This will help to protect your door. However, if you postpone or do not request having your door serviced and it requires having your door refinished, the HOA will only cover a portion of the cost to refinish and replace the weather strip. The HOA will pay a maximum of \$180 (the cost to the HOA for regular maintenance plus a 2nd coat of varnish). You will be responsible for the remaining cost of the door service. It is your responsibility to call and have it serviced every 2 years. Please call Jerry Marshburn at 281-998-7709 or come by or contact the Clubhouse at 281-464-3150 before October and get on the schedule. The doors are serviced March through October.
