

James Webster Reinders died at home in Houston, Texas on October 16, 2021.

Jim was above all a joy to know. He was an easy going and generous extrovert, his door always wide open to friends and family. Certainly, he was an interesting conversationalist and a captivating storyteller, but he was also an attentive and caring listener. It was his desire to make everyone's life a little better, easier, or more enjoyable. Jim was fun and quirky, and his needs were few as he enjoyed the simple pleasures of life, especially relaxing in the sunshine after lunch. He faithfully read the

Bible and The Imitation of Christ. He was a man of great strength, integrity, and character, living an exemplary life guided by his personal mantra, "Conceptualize, Visualize, Actualize."

Jim was born September 20, 1927 in Alliance, Nebraska to Herman and Kay Tickner Reinders. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 67 years, Violet Strong Reinders, his sister Phyllis Nelson, his brother Leonard Reinders, and his son-in-law Patrick McArdle. Jim is survived by his son James M. Reinders and daughter-in-law Andrea DeJohn Reinders, his daughter Janice McArdle, daughter Jody Cook and son-in-law Michael Cook and by his devoted friend, Nancy Hudson. Just as he was an extraordinary father, he was an extraordinary grand "Papa" to his grandchildren: Veronica Cook Scheibmeir (Paul), Peter McArdle, Jamaica Reinders Davis (Jonathan), Michael Andrew Cook (Rhonda), Kelly McArdle Millet (Matthew), James Cook (Rebecca), Alexis Reinders, Melinda Reinders, and James "Buck" Reinders, along with 17 great grandchildren and 2 great-great grandchildren.

Growing up on several farms near Alliance, Jim attended a one-room country school and graduated at age 16 from Alliance H.S. in 1944. Upon reaching 17 years of age, he was permitted to join the U.S. Navy and served in the South Pacific. Honorably discharged in 1946, he enrolled at the University of Nebraska and, appreciative of the help of the GI Bill and his wife, he graduated in 1950 with a B.S. in Electrical Engineering.

Jim's passion for travel was fulfilled during his career of 33 years in the oil industry, primarily with Schlumberger. His work took him to many states and over 30 countries spanning the globe. He and his wife lived in Tehran, Iran as he managed Persian Gulf operations from 1973 until 1976. The highlight of his career was acting as Technical Manager Europe from 1976 until 1981, residing in London and traveling throughout the Continent. Retired from Schlumberger

and back in the States, Jim served as Geo Van, Inc. President, retiring again in 1984. He then did general consulting work over the next 20 years.

Jim orchestrated and enjoyed many destination family reunions where old family traditions were passed along and hilarious new traditions and contests were instituted. He also took pleasure in his profession, poker, bridge, games of Trivial Pursuit, Toast Masters, sculpting, painting, hobby welding, hiking, biking, jogging and swimming. He participated in the Senior Olympics until he was 80 and until his final move to Houston, he annually ascended Wheeler Peak with the Over-the-Hill-Gang comprised of cherished comrades in Albuquerque.

Carhenge, constructed during a family reunion to replicate England's Stonehenge, was Jim's greatest artistic endeavor. He relished the international notoriety that Carhenge garnered: appearances on TV shows such as Connie Chung and To Tell the Truth, numerous newspaper and magazine interviews and stories, including those in Forbes and People, and the appearance of Carhenge in books, movies, videos and even on an album cover. He embraced his role at the Solar Eclipse '17 celebration held at Carhenge and most recently collaborated on his inclusion in the upcoming Dull Men's Club calendar of 2022.

Jim's family and many friends savored the time they shared. He was well loved. He will be greatly missed. Interment will be alongside his wife at the Nebraska Veterans Cemetery at Alliance.

A new weather strip on the bottom of the door is included, if needed. This will help to protect your door. However, if you postpone or do not request having your door serviced and it requires having your door refinished, the HOA will only cover a portion of the cost to refinish and replace the weather strip. The HOA will pay a maximum of \$180 (the cost to the HOA for regular maintenance plus a 2nd coat of varnish). You will be responsible for the remaining cost of the door service. It is your responsibility to call and have it serviced every 2 years. Please call Jerry Marshburn at 281-998-7709 or come by or contact the Clubhouse at 281-464-3150 before October and get on the schedule. The doors are serviced March through October.
