#### **Scarsdale Wall Project**


The BellaVita Board of Director's have awarded a contract to Aber Fence and Supply Company to remove the existing precast concrete wall along Scarsdale Boulevard and BellaVita Drive and replace the existing wall with a new 8-foot-high precast concrete wall (see attached picture). BellaVita requested proposals from four contractors, but only two firms submitted a proposal and bid.

This project has been in the planning for about two years. A well attended open forum last June outlined the history of the existing wall, maintenance issues, and need for constructing a new wall. Once the contract is fully executed, there will be approximately a 60- day period where the new precast panels will be fabricated at a nearby factory. No construction work at BellaVita will be performed during that 60- day period. Sometime after the first of the year, Aber Fence will remove the existing concrete wall, install a temporary chain link fence on each property, install posts for the new wall, then the new wall panels will be installed. We anticipate all work will be complete before April 1<sup>st</sup>.

A member of the Task Force will contact all 50 homeowners directly impacted by this project to document the existing conditions and answer any questions. Furthermore, we plan on holding another open forum to introduce the contractor, discuss the construction process and answer any homeowner questions.



#### THE HANDS

Ever wonder how the practice of raising the right hand in court came about?

In seventeenth century London, convicted criminals were often branded on their right thumb in lieu of a more severe sentence. If they were ever accused of another crime, the judge would force them to "raise their right hand" to provide evidence of a previous conviction. After branding was abolished, the practice of raising the right hand in court continued as a means of swearing to truthfulness when testifying or swearing an oath.

What sets our hands apart from other animals is our opposable thumbs—this means our thumbs and fingers can work together (fun fact: koala bears also have opposable thumbs)

You cannot get a tan on your palm and underside of your fingers

Fingerprints are a completely unique DNA imprint that is different in every single human being. No two human beings in the world have similar fingerprints.

There are tons of words that include the word 'hand': handy, handwriting, handiwork, handle, handbag, handsome, handball, etc.

The average hand length for adult women is 6.7 inches. The average length for men is 7.4 inches

Fingers don't have muscles—tendons in our fingers are moved by the muscles of the forearm

Men tend to have longer ring fingers than index fingers—girls vice versa

Hand surgeons say that the index finger is the best one to lose—if you had a choice. The index finger is needed the least

Your fingernails show your state of health—they can indicate problems such as mineral or vitamin deficiencies, liver trouble, thyroid or anemia. Some warning signs of deficiencies that show up on your nails may be that they are brittle, pale or spotted.

The color of the nails and those small "moons" on each nail can identify the quality of oxygen level of the bloodstream and blood circulation

Our fingers are even more sensitive than the eyes—the fingertips have a large number of receptors responsible for sending messages to the brain.


